

AMENDMENT NUMBER 3 TO “AGREEMENT FOR CONTRACT SERVICES”


THIS AMENDMENT NUMBER 3 TO AGREEMENT FOR CONTRACT SERVICES (the "Third Amendment") is made and entered into as of August 16, 2024 by and between the CITY OF IRVINE, a municipal corporation ("City") and CINTAS CORPORATION No. 2, a Nevada corporation ("Contractor"), for the purpose of amending the written "Agreement for Contract Services" entered into between City and Contractor as of January 20, 2023, City of Irvine contract number 20709 (the "Agreement").

1. PART V, BUDGET, is modified to increase the not-to-exceed contract value by \$100,000.00 from \$200,000.00 to \$300,000.00 in accordance with EXHIBIT I, attached hereto.
2. Except as set forth in this Third Amendment, all terms, conditions and provisions of the Agreement are unchanged and remain in full force and effect.
