

**AMENDMENT NUMBER 1  
TO “AGREEMENT FOR TRADES-RELATED SERVICES”**


THIS AMENDMENT NUMBER 1 TO AGREEMENT FOR TRADES-RELATED SERVICES (the “First Amendment”) is made and entered into as of May 22, 2025 by and between the CITY OF IRVINE, a municipal corporation (“City”) and CONVERGINT TECHNOLOGIES, LLC, a Delaware limited liability partnership (“Contractor”), for the purpose of amending the written “Agreement for Trades-Related Services” entered into between City and Contractor as of January 31, 2025, City of Irvine contract number 21859 (the “Agreement”).

1. The expiration date of the Agreement remains unchanged of January 31, 2026.
2. PART V, BUDGET, is modified to increase the not-to-exceed contract value by \$10,678.00 from \$5,128.00 to \$15,896.00, in accordance with EXHIBIT I attached hereto.
3. Except as set forth in this First Amendment, all terms, conditions and provisions of the Agreement are unchanged and remain in full force and effect.

**Scope of Work**

Convergint Technologies' scope of work includes furnishing, installing, programming and commissioning the material listed in the attached bill of materials (BOM) as outlined below and with regards to the data listed in the clarifications and exclusions section of this proposal. Proposal complies with prevailing wage labor requirements.

The scope of work of this change order is to install a new Genetec access control panel to replicate the existing panel setup. Convergint will provide, assemble, and install the new panel in an area determined by the City within the same IDF room. Convergint will then run new wires from new panel to existing panel and leave coiled up until time of cutover. Once the new panel is installed and powered up, Convergint and the City will determine a suitable time to perform the cutover. After cutover, Convergint will test to ensure proper system functionality and will then proceed to remove the old equipment. Customer to provide power at new panel location. Convergint will provide installation staff, project specialists, and project management to oversee implementation.

**Warranty**

Convergint will provide a one-year labor warranty and a one-year material warranty on equipment provided by Convergint. Provision of labor and materials after the first year will be billed on a time and materials basis.
