

**AMENDMENT NUMBER 1  
TO “AGREEMENT FOR TRADES-RELATED SERVICES”**


THIS AMENDMENT NUMBER 1 TO AGREEMENT FOR TRADES-RELATED SERVICES (the “First Amendment”) is made and entered into as of March 30, 2026 by and between the CITY OF IRVINE, a municipal corporation (“City”) and WWC SERVICES, INC., a California corporation (“Contractor”), for the purpose of amending the written “Agreement for Trades-Related Services” entered into between City and Contractor as of January 26, 2026, City of Irvine contract number 22729 (the “Agreement”).

1. PART V, BUDGET, is modified to increase the not-to-exceed contract value by \$3,750.00 from \$24,950.00 to \$28,700.00.
2. Except as set forth in this First Amendment, all terms, conditions and provisions of the Agreement are unchanged and remain in full force and effect.






